designation

To qualify for a Greater Houston Builders
Association (GHBA) Professional Builder (PB)
designation the candidate must demonstrate
certain attributes by being a member in good
standing with the GHBA, participate in required
educational classroom hours, follow the GHBA
code of ethics. The PB designation demonstrates
a level of professionalism that is unique to Gulf
Coast area builders. As a PB the builder shall
support their industry through their participation
and by attending continuing education events.

GHBA Professional Builder (PB) Initial Requirements:

- Be a GHBA member, or employed by a GHBA member company, in good standing
- Have built at least one home in the last 24 months
- Attend 12 ABCs of Homebuilding classes, with a passing exam score of 80%
- Attend a GHBA-sponsored Ethics course
- OSHA 10 Hour Card required
- Upon completion of all requirements pay a Graduation Application fee of \$65

Designation Renewal

(Every 12 months after initial designation)

- Be a GHBA member, or employed by a GHBA member company, in good standing
- Attend 3 ABC's of Homebuilding classes, with a passing exam score of 80% in 12-month period
- Pay annual renewal fee of \$45
